DESCRIPTION

The Battery Room Safety Awareness course provides personnel entering a battery room with basic knowledge of battery systems, electrical and chemical hazards, required PPE, recommended safety practices, and battery room safety procedures. Based on the Safety Section of IEEE document P1657 (Recommended Practices for Personnel Qualifications for Installation and Maintenance of Stationary Batteries) and NFPA 70E Standard for Electrical Safety in the Work place, this course provides training to facilities and contractors with personnel that will work with or enter battery rooms.

COURSE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Follow safety practices in room during battery installation
- Understand electrical shock, ventilation, and fire hazards
- Know the required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Recommended tools and use of battery blankets
- Follow safety practices in room during battery installation
- · Identify safe working clearances, egress paths, and task lighting
